PALMERSTON ROAD UPGRADES

Roystonea Avenue / Temple Terrace intersection to Terry Drive, Gunn

EXCAVATION WORKS START WEDNESDAY 24 FEBRUARY

The Northern Territory Government is undertaking a series of road improvements in and around Palmerston which started in 2015 and will continue this year.

With Palmerston being one of Australia's fastest growing cities, the Northern Territory Government is committed to ensuring the road network is upgraded to ensure it services the growth of the region.

Duplication road works on Roystonea Avenue are now moving towards Terry Drive.

Excavation works continue on Roystonea Avenue, adjacent to the property boundaries of residences on Fish River Way, Gunn. These works will provide additional lanes to cater for growing demand in the area and improve road safety.

Works will take place during the day and include the use of an excavator. Residents may experience an increase in noise. Appropriate measures will be taken to reduce and suppress noise wherever possible.

During these works, temporary speed restrictions and lane closures will also be in place.

We appreciate your patience while we deliver these important upgrades. Excavation works will be finished by mid April, with overall project completion anticipated for October 2016.
