ITEM 1 PART CHANGE OF USE FROM HOTEL TO CHILD CARE CENTRE (LEVEL 1) PA2021/0408

APPLICANT LOT 6517 (21) KNUCKEY STREET, DARWIN CITY, TOWN OF DARWIN Cunnington Rosse Town Planning and Consulting

- **RESOLVED**That, pursuant to section 46(4)(b) of the *Planning Act 1999*, the Development**31/22**Consent defer consideration of the application to develop Lot 6517 (21) Knuckey<br/>Street, Darwin City, Town of Darwin for the purpose of part change of use from<br/>hotel to child care centre (level 1) to require the applicant to provide the following<br/>additional information that the Authority considers necessary in order to enable<br/>proper consideration of the application:
  - Written confirmation from Quality Education and Care NT (QECNT) that concerns raised in its comments dated 18 May 2022 regarding the location of the waiting room and associated access arrangements have been resolved; and
  - Amended plans addressing any changes necessary to reflect the requirements of QECNT and elevation plans of shade structures over the covered play area and outdoor play area.

#### **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant is required to address the concerns raised by Quality Education and Care NT (QECNT) in its comments dated 18 May 2022 regarding the location of the proposed waiting room and associated access arrangements to ensure that the child care centre incorporates appropriate site layout and building design, and, to provide amended plans, as necessary, to reflect such changes required to address those concerns..

Elevation plans of shade structures over the covered play area and outdoor play area are required to demonstrate the layout of outdoor areas.

While the Authority considers that the comments received from QECNT on 18 May 2022 mainly detail legislative requirements, standards and best practices which relate to child care centres;, the comments regarding the location of the waiting room and associated access arrangements will likely result in design changes which could alter the proposal significantly. The Authority therefore considers it would be imprudent to issue a development permit and endorse associated drawings until this matter is resolved.
