Civic and State Square Revitalisation

Lawn and landscape upgrades

Dear Stakeholder

The Northern Territory Government is continuing to revitalise the Civic and State Square Precinct in the Darwin CBD.

Starting from 11 July 2022, the lawn at the site of the former Chan building and adjacent landscape spaces will receive a range of enhancements to improve usability and visual amenity of the space. Works will include:

- landscaping such as planting tropical varieties and improving garden beds
- enhancing pedestrian connections between Bennett Park, the Supreme Court and Parliament House
- additional shaded seating
- electrical services to enable community events on the lawn.

Works will occur over the coming months between the hours of 6:00am and 5:30pm Monday to Friday. Some work on Saturdays may be required. Work is expected to be completed before the end of the year.

During this time, foot access to the area may be limited and pedestrians are encouraged to seek alternative routes to reach their destination.

There will be minimal impact to vehicle traffic including to Parliament House, however approximately 8 car parks near the former Chan building will be unavailable during works.
