

New Offences

Offences below have been summarised. Refer to draft regulations for actual wording.

Offences with wide application

9(1)	Safety of Vehicles- the operator of a CPV must not allow the vehicle to be used for hire or reward if the vehicle is unsafe	85	15 (person) 25 (corporation)
9(2)	Safety of Vehicles- the operator of a CPV must ensure maintenance is carried out on the vehicle in accordance with any specification from the Registrar of Motor Vehicles	85	15 (person) 25 (corporation)
9(3)	Safety of Vehicles- the driver must not drive a CPV if the driver knows the vehicle is unsafe	85	15
10	A person must not smoke in a CPV (other than courtesy vehicle)	30	3
11	Assistance animals - The driver of a CPV must not refuse a hiring because a person is accompanied by an assistance animal	30	5

Levy Offences

Note - Primarily concerns only operators of taxi, minibus and private hire vehicles, and rideshare platform managers.

18(1)	A person liable to pay the levy must not knowingly evade the levy	85
18(2)	Person liable for the levy must provide monthly returns on the number of transactions involving person's vehicles	85
18(3)	Person liable for the levy must keep records necessary to ascertain the person's liability for the levy	85
18(4)	Person liable for the levy must produce records upon request by the regulator	85
18(5)	Person liable must retain records for 3 years	85
18(6)	Person liable must not mislead the regulator about their levy liability	85

Offences pertaining to Ridesharing only

9	Driver must supply information to the regulator when requested	30	5
10	Driver must not accept a journey other than through a rideshare platform	60	6

12	Driver must ensure that vehicle displays the approved label	30	3
13	Driver must take shortest practicable route	25	3
14	Driver must not purchase alcohol on behalf of another person	25	5
15	No touting	25	3
16	No advertising on vehicle which indicates vehicle is available for hire	40	5
17	Driver must not park in taxi or minibus rank, or place marked for private hire cars	25	3
