

Nightcliff schools traffic calming initiatives

Factsheet

Dear Stakeholder,

The Northern Territory Government in collaboration with the City of Darwin are undertaking traffic calming initiatives and associated pedestrian and cyclist crossing improvements along Nightcliff Road to provide a safer environment for pedestrians and cyclists.

The Nightcliff Walk and Wheel Project Study completed in 2019 identified schools in Nightcliff as a priority area for traffic calming improvements.

Work will include three pedestrian crossing improvements on Nightcliff Road as follows;

- A signalised pedestrian crossing at the end of Cypress Street for students accessing Nightcliff Primary School and Nightcliff Middle School,
- a signalised pedestrian crossing in the vicinity of Fox Crescent and Camphor Street intersections and
- a pedestrian refuge crossing immediately south of the intersection with Chapman for students accessing the Essington School.

Further information on the design and proposed construction works on Nightcliff Road will be communicated in the coming weeks.
