



PALMERSTON ROAD UPGRADES

ROYSTONEA AVENUE AND TEMPLE TERRACE

The Northern Territory Government is undertaking a comprehensive series of road improvements over 2015 and 2016 that will provide for a safe traffic environment, whilst allowing for a greater movement of vehicles in the area and for future development of the city.

As part of these changes, staged road works will soon commence at the below locations:

1. Roystonea Avenue/Temple Terrace intersection
2. Roystonea Avenue from Temple Terrace to Terry Drive
3. Temple Terrace from Roystonea Avenue to Stuart Highway.

ROYSTONEA AVENUE/TEMPLE TERRACE INTERSECTION

Road works will begin at this intersection in mid-November and include:

- Lengthening of turn lanes into and out of Roystonea Avenue
- Additional turn and through lanes at lights for traffic turning into Roystonea Avenue
- Modifications to traffic islands.

While the works are in progress, motorists are urged to travel with care and adhere to all traffic management in place. Lane closures and speed restrictions are to be expected, with some night works planned to minimise impact on road users.
