

Floor level survey

Alice Springs flood mitigation

The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics is conducting a floor level survey of habitable buildings across the Alice Springs region.

The purpose of the survey is to obtain floor level information and understand flooding depths at individual property levels for properties identified as impacted by riverine or stormwater flooding.

The survey will take place over the next four months, from 15 June 2020 to 14 October 2020 and will include the Alice Springs CBD, East Side, Stuart, Braitling, Gillen, The Gap, Arumbera, Connellan, Desert Springs, Ilparpa and Ross.

The surveying will use laser technology to record floor level heights and surveyors may require access to your property, but will not require entry to any buildings.

The floor level data from the survey will identify potential above floor level flooding of properties for a variety of flood events. This information will help develop effective flood mitigation options for Alice Springs with the aim to reduce above-floor flooding for those properties potentially impacted.

The survey work is separated into four areas and the proposed dates for survey are:

Dates	Suburbs
15 June - 14 July	East Side, Stuart, Braitling
15 July - 14 August	Gillen, Larapinta
15 August - 14 September	Alice Springs CBD, The Gap, Desert Springs, Mount Johns
15 September - 14 October	Ilparpa, Ross, Arumbera
