Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road Overpass Project update

Dear Stakeholder

The new outbound lanes of Tiger Brennan Drive heading towards Palmerston are now connected to the existing lanes, allowing road users to utilise these lanes, passing under the bridge carrying Berrimah Road over Tiger Brennan Drive.

Works to finalise the tie-in of the new lanes to the existing lanes are being undertaken.

These works will be undertaken at night to reduce disruption for road users.

Closure of the Tiger Brennan Drive Palmerston-bound lanes, between Amy Johnson Avenue and Tivendale/Wishart Roads intersection, will take place:

• 6pm Wednesday 1 May to 6am Thursday 2 May.

Over the following week, single lane closures near the overpass are planned to complete barrier works. This will occur during the day, outside of peak traffic hours.

Due to continuing works in and around the area, a reduced speed limit continues to be in place.

The Palmerston to Darwin inbound lanes will remain open at all times.

Every effort has been made to limit construction time and disruptions, while ensuring improved safety for road users and construction workers.

Road users are advised to follow all traffic management in place.
