

## **ROYSTONEA AVENUE EXTENSION BETWEEN LAMBRICK AND OWSTON AVENUE'S WORKS COMMENCE MID FEBRUARY 2016**

The Northern Territory Government is undertaking a series of road improvements in and around Palmerston which started in 2015 and will continue this year. With Palmerston being one of Australia's fastest growing cities, the Northern Territory Government is committed to ensuring the road network is upgraded to ensure it services the growth of the region.

To cater for access to Zuccoli, Weddell and future land developments, Roystonea Avenue will be extended from the Lambrick Avenue intersection to the Southern Connector Road (road yet to be officially named).

Work on the new 1.22km section of road will commence mid February 2016 and include:

- Construction of two intersections at Belyuen Road and Southern Connector Road
- Construction of a shared user path along the new section of Roystonea Avenue
- Relocation of essential services
- Installation and improvements to street lighting, and landscaping.

The impact on neighbouring residents will be minimised where possible and appropriate measures will be taken to minimise and suppress dust and noise. Throughout the project, mechanisms to monitor the environment (air, water and noise) will be in place.
