



PALMERSTON ROAD UPGRADES

ROYSTONEA AVENUE/TEMPLE TERRACE INTERSECTION

Road works

Delivery of the Northern Territory Governments' Palmerston Road Upgrades program is underway, which will provide a safe traffic environment and allow for a greater movement of vehicles in and around the Palmerston City. Work on the first stage of the Roystonea Avenue/Temple Terrace intersection upgrade will start from

Wednesday, 25 November 2015. Works include:

- Relocation of services
- Clearing and earthworks

Day works will take place outside of the traditional busy weekday morning and afternoon traffic flow times.

Night works may be required between the hours of 7pm to 6am Monday to Friday. The contractor is using technology to reduce the noise typically associated with reversing vehicles. The concentrated directional reversing alarm can only be heard by workers in the immediate vicinity of the works.

During works, motorists are urged to travel with care in the area and adhere to all traffic management in place. Road users are advised that lane closures, speed restrictions are expected. Some delays may be experienced.
