

PALMERSTON ROAD UPGRADES ROYSTONEA AVENUE - THIRD LANE

The Northern Territory Government is undertaking a series of road improvements in and around Palmerston which started in 2015 and will continue this year. With Palmerston being one of Australia's fastest growing cities, the Northern Territory Government is committed to ensuring the road network is upgraded to ensure it services the growth of the region.

Works will soon start on the construction of the third lane outbound on Roystonea Avenue between the Tiger Brennan Drive overpass, Palmerston and the Temple Terrace intersection.

Motorists may experience short delays while we deliver these improvements. Please allow extra time/take an alternative route for travel along Roystonea Avenue during busy periods. Works include:

- New intersection to new commercial development
- Upgrade of intersection at Yarrowonga Road / Packard Avenue
- Upgrade of intersection at University Avenue
- Upgrade of intersection at The Boulevard.

To minimise disruption to traffic, majority of works will take place outside of peak hours of travel. Temporary speed restrictions and lane closures will be in place. Some night works will be required. Access to businesses will remain at all times. Work will be completed late 2016.
