

John Stokes Square Redevelopment

Project update

Construction of storm water drainage; electrical, water and sewer reticulation; local council road layout; shared paths; landscaping and lighting; public open space; and car parking is underway to complete the redevelopment of John Stokes Square.

Planned changed traffic conditions

The map over the page illustrates the planned traffic conditions and worksites that may be in place during different stages of construction.

The proposed maps are indicative only and traffic conditions are subject to change during construction.

All efforts will be made to minimise disruption to pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, however we ask everyone to adhere to the traffic management in place.

The central pedestrian crossing will be temporarily closed during construction with alternative crossings across Progress Drive provided at each end of the works.

The shared path within the works area (running east-west) will also be temporarily closed during construction. Cyclists are encouraged to utilise the pedestrian crossings and pathways or follow the detours in place for vehicles, as they deem appropriate.

Temporary bus stop relocation

Bus stop 86 near the Progress Drive shops will be temporarily closed during construction. Passengers and school buses normally using this bus stop will be able to use a temporary bus stop set up on Pavonia Place from 12 April.

This temporary bus stop will be in effect for approximately 6 months.

A number of car parks will be removed temporarily along Pavonia Place, Phoenix Street and Oleander Street near the back of the Nightcliff shops to allow the bus to access the temporary bus stop.


