Leanyer Primary School New classroom building

Dear stakeholder,

The Northern Territory Government is constructing a new classroom building at Leanyer Primary School.

The project is part of Leanyer Primary School's infrastructure master plan, and will provide quality, contemporary learning spaces for students.

The new building will replace four old demountable classrooms with brand new facilities including:

- four classrooms
- a breakout space
- a teachers office
- an outdoor learning space and
- a plant room to house the air conditioning plant.

Demolition works will be carried out over the coming weeks from 13 January 2021, with construction commencing thereafter. Works are expected to be completed in June 2021.

All efforts will be made to mitigate dust, noise and increased traffic movements where possible.

The worksite will be cordoned off to minimise disruption and ensure staff and student safety.
