

Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road overpass

Marlow Rd/Berrimah Rd intersection closure

Dear Stakeholder,

The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics is constructing an overpass at the Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road intersection.

The new overpass will carry Berrimah Road traffic over Tiger Brennan Drive, separating the major flow of traffic on Tiger Brennan Drive from the traffic movements on Berrimah Road enabling the continuous flow of traffic and improved safety.

Prior to opening Berrimah Road North, a temporary closure of the Marlow Road and Berrimah Road intersection is required.

The closure will occur from Monday 29 July and is expected to re-open by the end of September 2024.

Access to surrounding businesses and properties will be maintained at all times, however a detour via Strath Road will be in place.

Please allow extra time when travelling through and adhere to traffic management in the area.

The next stage of the project will include the staged reconnection of the Tiger Brennan Drive Palmerston bound on and off ramps and the re-opening of Berrimah Road North.
