

Proposed safety improvements to Schwarz Crescent

The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics and Alice Springs Town Council are looking at how to improve safety on the Stuart Highway at Schwarz Crescent.

A concept design is featured overleaf for your information and comment.

Schwarz Crescent is the main access from the Stuart Highway to St Philip's College and Anzac Hill. Pedestrians and vehicles do not get safe gaps in traffic to cross the Stuart Highway at the existing location. To address this, the Department commissioned a study to improve safety at the intersection of Stuart Highway and Schwarz Crescent.

About the concept design

The concept design proposes to realign Schwarz Crescent by shifting its intersection with Stuart Highway towards north. To do this, the existing Smith Street/Stuart Highway junction will become a new four-way signalised intersection.

The new design will provide a safe and reliable crossing of the Stuart Highway for all road users including pedestrians and cyclists.

Alice Springs Town Council is the road authority for Schwarz Crescent and supports the proposed realignment and new signalised intersection.

This is a planning study only. There are no funds for construction at this stage.
